INFORMATION LETTER

In order to ensure the implementation of the Resolution of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. PP-4843 dated 28 September 2020 “On the Organization and Conduct of the International Festival ‘Lazgi’”, as well as to assess and provide a scientific justification of the level of Uzbek national dance art in reflecting universal human and national values, an international scientific and practical conference entitled **“Dance Art in Global Cultural Development: Traditions and Universal Human Values”**, dedicated to the study of Uzbek and world dance art, will be held on 27 April 2026 in Khiva.

Date of the conference: 27 April 2026.

Conference venue: Republic of Uzbekistan, Khorezm Region, Khiva city.

Purpose of the conference: the preservation and development of the art of Khorezm dance “Lazgi” and the ancient traditions of other peoples; the exchange of experience in various fields of dance art; and the strengthening of friendship and brotherhood, creative cooperation, and cultural ties at the international level through the means of dance art.

Within the framework of the conference, sections will be organized in the following areas:

1. Khorezm dance “Lazgi”: historical-philosophical and national-cultural factors
2. Development of choreographic art in the process of globalization

Professors, researchers, master’s students, undergraduate students, and specialists in the field from higher educational institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan and foreign countries are invited to participate in the conference.

Forms of participation: offline, online.

Working languages of the conference: Uzbek, Russian, English.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ARTICLE SUBMISSION

1. The length of the text must not exceed 5-7 pages.
2. The text must be prepared in Microsoft Office Word with the following formatting: font – Times New Roman; main text – 14-point font size; line spacing – 1.5; top and bottom margins – 2 cm; left margin – 3 cm; right margin – 1.5 cm; A4 format; no hyphenation; no page numbering.

The author's surname and first name, academic degree and title, position, name of the organization, city, and country must be indicated in the language of the article (aligned to the right).

The title of the article must be written in bold capital letters.

An abstract of 3-4 lines and keywords (no more than 8 words) in Uzbek, Russian, and English must be provided after the title of the article.

References in the article should be formatted in the traditional manner. A list of references (at least 8 sources) must be provided at the end of the article.

Authors bear responsibility for the content, academic quality, and accuracy of the information presented in the article.

The submitted article must not have been previously published in other printed editions. Articles that do not meet the conference requirements or are submitted after the specified deadline will not be accepted for publication.
